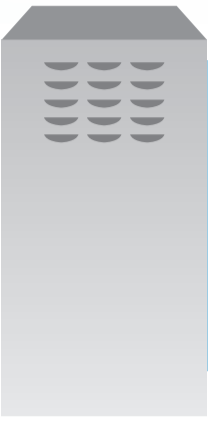


CAN YOUR FURNACE

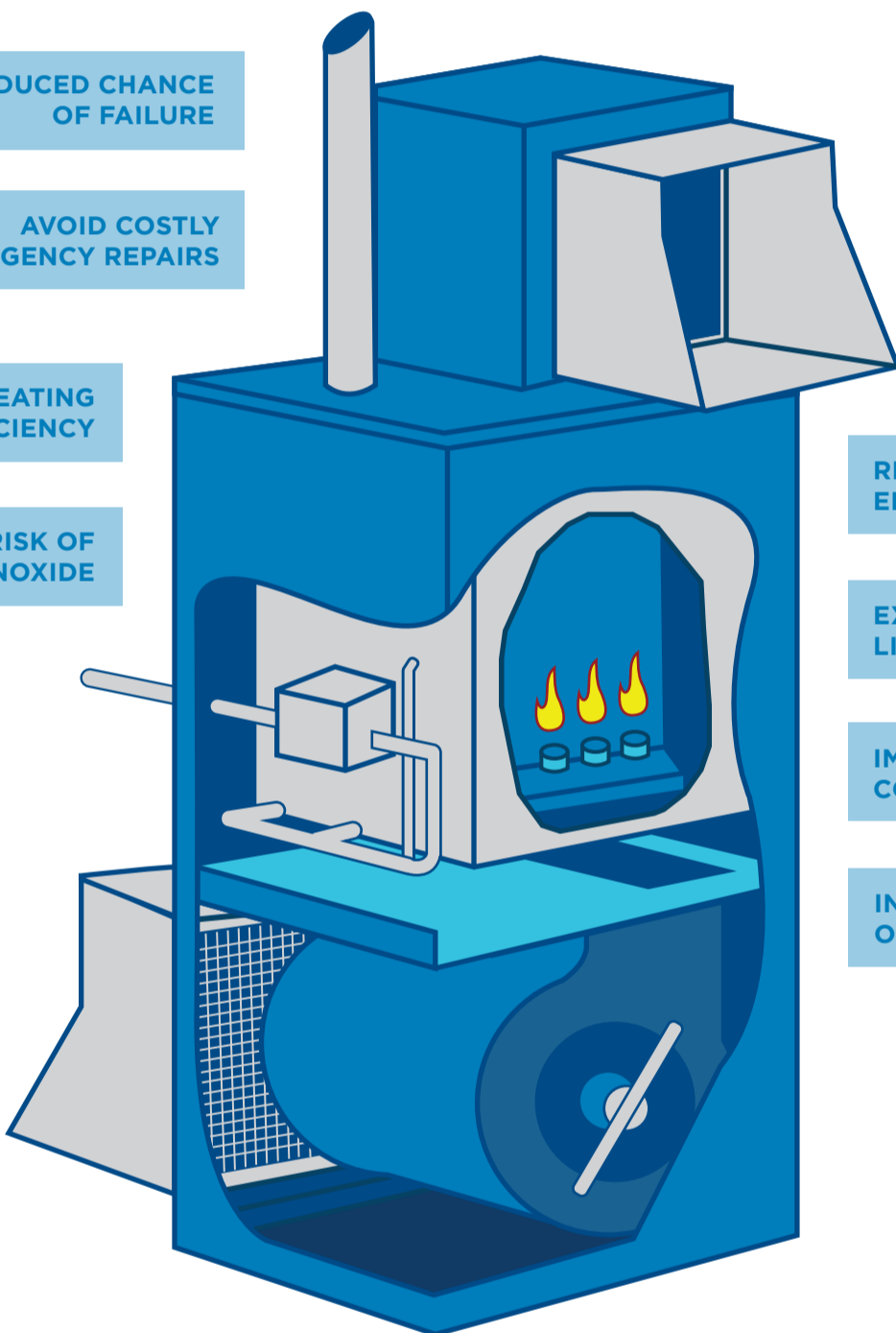
